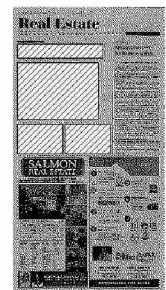

The event’s premier sponsors are the National Association of Realtors (NAR) and the New York State Association of Realtors (NYSAR).

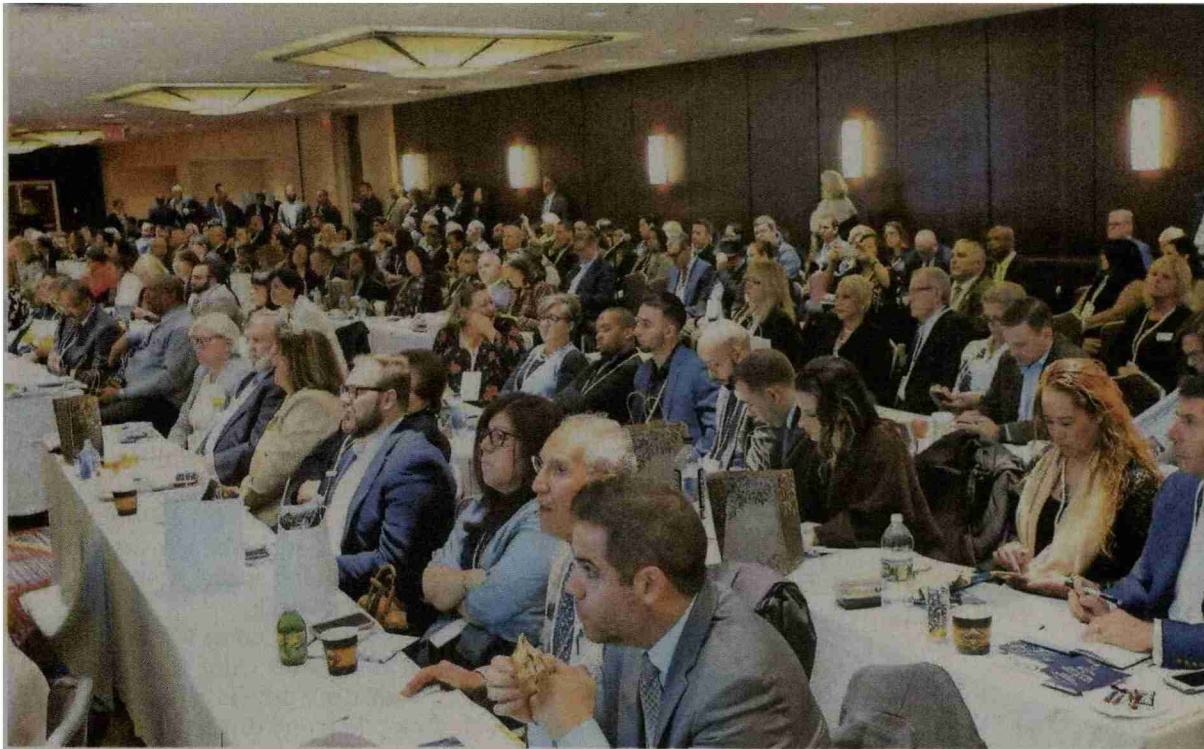
