

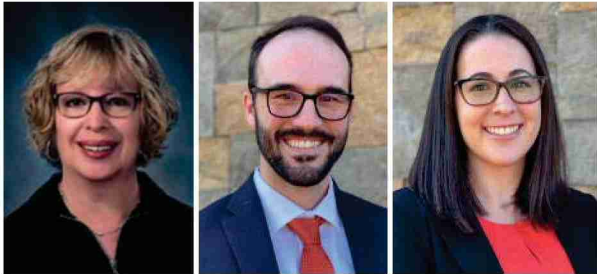
Stokes & Company Welcomes Three New Hires

Powersville Water Board of Directors approved a financial plan and rate structure for 2021. Water rates will not be increased. Each year Powersville Water completes an update of its comprehensive Financial Plan and Rate Model to ensure that rates are adequate to cover projected expenses for the coming year.
