

Harwich Cultural Council 2021 Grant Recipients

HARWICH– The Harwich Cultural Council has announced this year’s grant recipients. A total of 16 projects in three categories (arts, humanities, interpretive sciences) were awarded grants for the 2021 fiscal year.

Recipients are: The Harwich Cranberry Festival received \$1,000 for CranFest in the Courtyard; Kristin Stewart received \$250 for Cold Frame Theatre Outdoor Spring Production; Makers Club received \$400 for Dot to Dot Workshop; Cape Cod Theatre Company received \$2,000 for The Free Plays; Naomi Steckman received \$500 for Beyond the Bounds: A Pandemic Concert Series; Lucy Gilmore received \$935 for Creative Movement; Sharon Leder received \$300 for Creative Outlets: Finding Your Voice Through Arts; Monika Woods received \$300 for Open Mic Classical; Harwich Historical Society received \$800 for Accessibility Improvement Project; Alzheimer’s Family Support Center received

\$400 for Arts and Ideas for Patients and Caregivers; Cultural Center of Cape Cod received \$615 for Rise and Shine; Eventide Theatre Company received \$300 for Eventide Tales; Cape Cod Chamber Orchestra received \$500 for a Virtual Concert at the Heritage Museum; Cape Cod Poetry Review received \$400 for Poetry Review Issue 7; Guild of Harwich Artists received \$500 for Hands-On Art Exploration; and Harwich Town Band received \$800 for Harwich Town Band performances.

The Harwich Cultural Council is a town-appointed committee funded in part by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts through the Massachusetts Cultural Council and the town of Harwich.
